



Phosphating Tech Session Recap

Our phosphating tech session began as usual - eating donuts! This time though, we got to admire the beautiful 1969 Cougar Craig is restoring for his wife Julie while we ate. It's a beautiful car, and we're excited to see it when it's finished!

Then it was time for business. The first step in phosphating is safety! Craig had gloves and steel tongs to avoid contact with the chemicals. The second step is making sure all the parts are clean -- and Craig has very high standards! After bead-blasting and scraping all the paint, grease, and grime off the hood hinges and springs we brought, it was time to phosphate. Craig brought water to a boil in a tank, and then added in the phosphoric acid. The mix ratio is 8 ounces of phosphoric acid per a gallon of water. Once the solution was ready, it was time to add the car parts. Careful not to splash when adding the parts to the solution though! Once the parts are submerged, you have to move them around to ensure that any surface bubbles that form on the parts are eliminated. The typical time to phosphate is about 10 minutes, though leaving them in for longer can produce a darker finish. We pulled the parts out and put them in a plastic bucket and immediately sprayed them down with WD-40. This helps to remove the mineral salts that form on the parts when they're submerged. Once the parts dry, you've got a concours phosphate finish!

Thank you to Craig and Julie Johnson for hosting the tech session, sharing his garage, and showing us how the phosphating process is done. If you're interested in restoring your car parts with this finish, contact Craig for more info!


Old Business – none.

Membership Meetings

Meetings are typically held the first Friday of every month at 7:00pm at Bowen Scarff Ford in Kent (1157 Central Avenue North). Due to Covid, they are currently being held virtually via Zoom.

Community Support

Pacific Cascade Mustang Club has donated tens of thousands of dollars over the years to support local charities through our activities, events and annual car show. Annual Car Show

PCMC and Bowen Scarff Ford in Kent host our annual All Ford Show and Mustang Roundup in August. The show is open to all Ford, Lincoln and Mercury-powered vehicles.

Tours and Events

PCMC takes part in numerous events including garage tours, recreational outings, car show caravans, tech sessions and a monthly dinner night out. Dinner night out takes place on the 13th of every month. If the 13th falls on a weekend, we try to organize a local trip or tour for the day.

Tech Sessions

The club hosts various tech sessions for members to learn more about restoring, repairing and maintaining their Mustangs. Tech sessions are typically held on an as-needed basis and have included topics like cleaning and detailing, front-end suspension, electrical, wiring, brakes and differentials.
